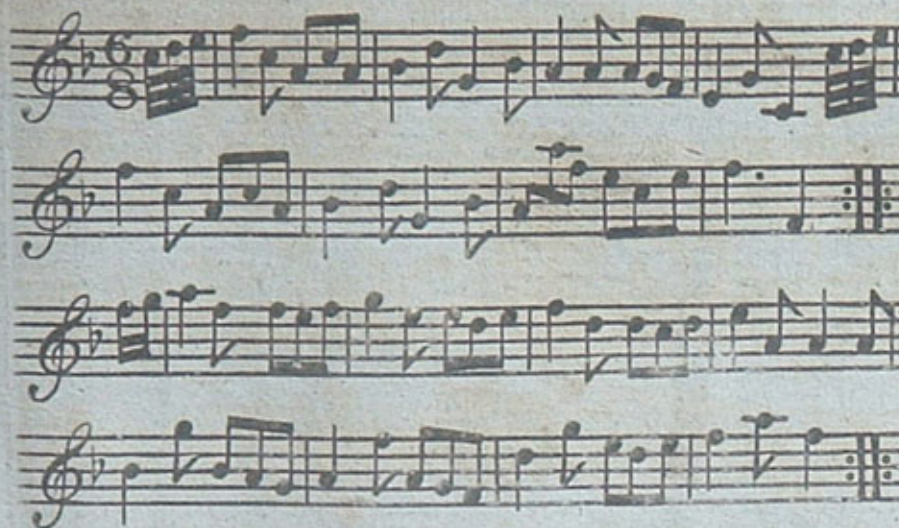

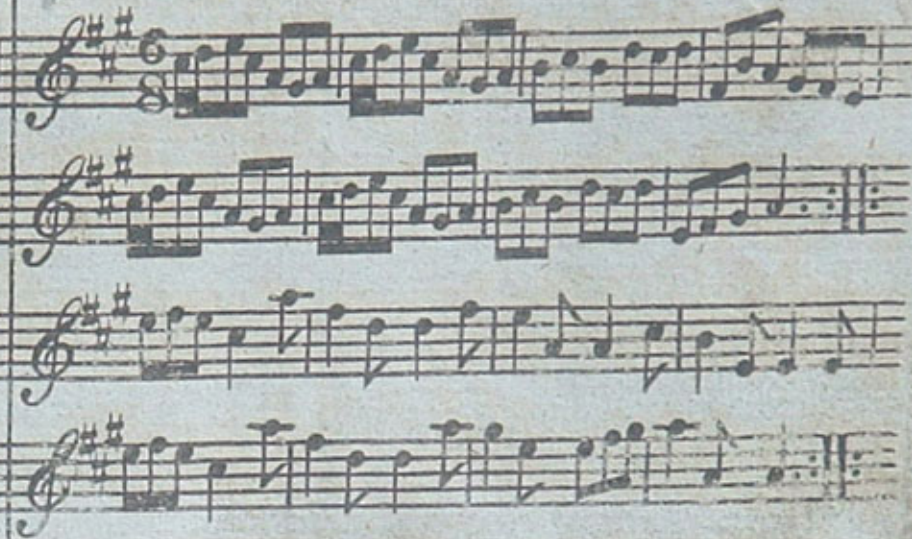

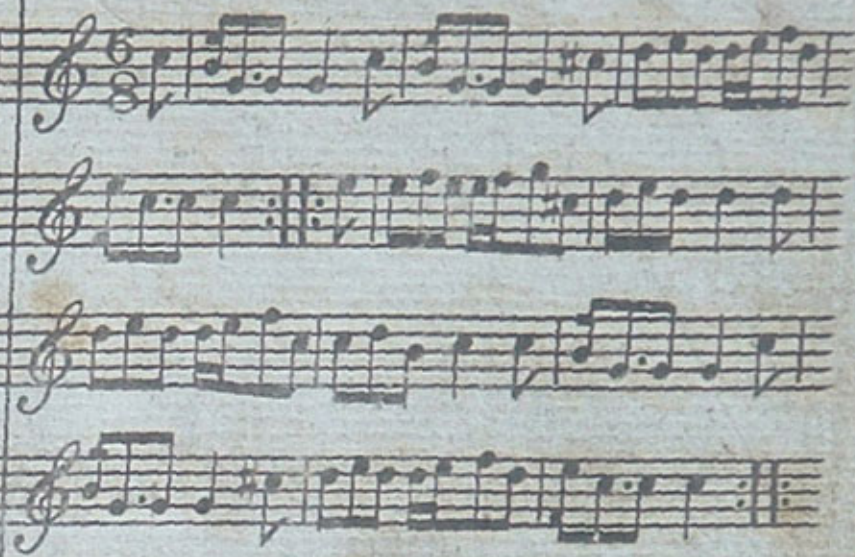
The British Sailors Hornpipe.

Conquer or Die.

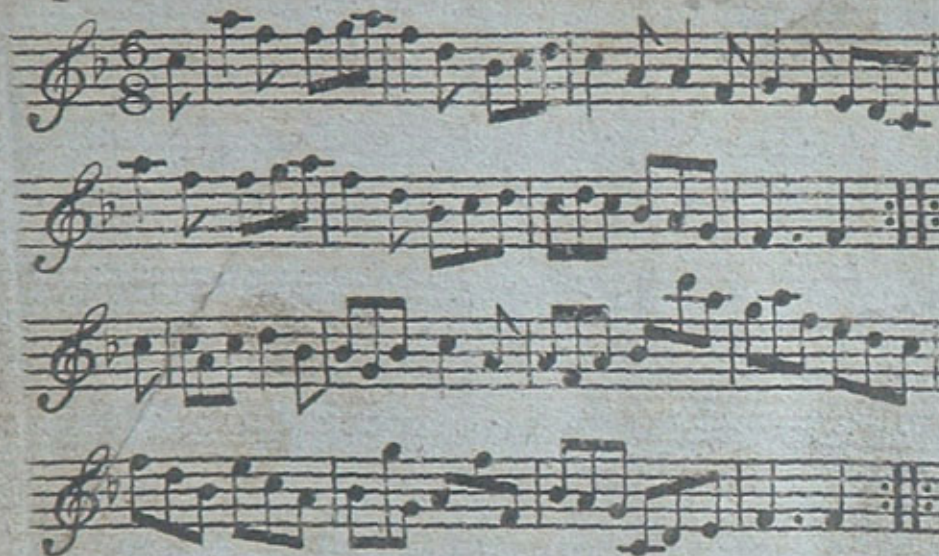

Fortunes Wheel.



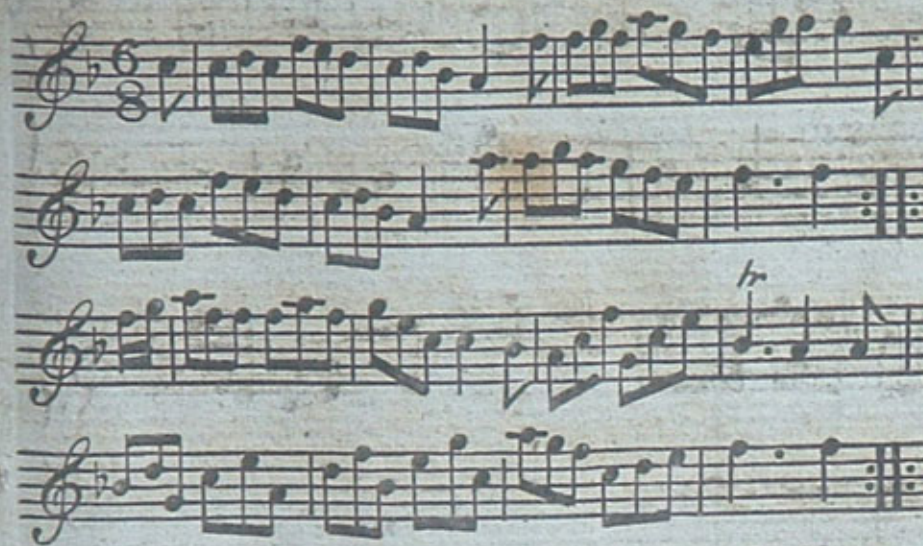
The 1st and 2^d Couple fet all four and hands

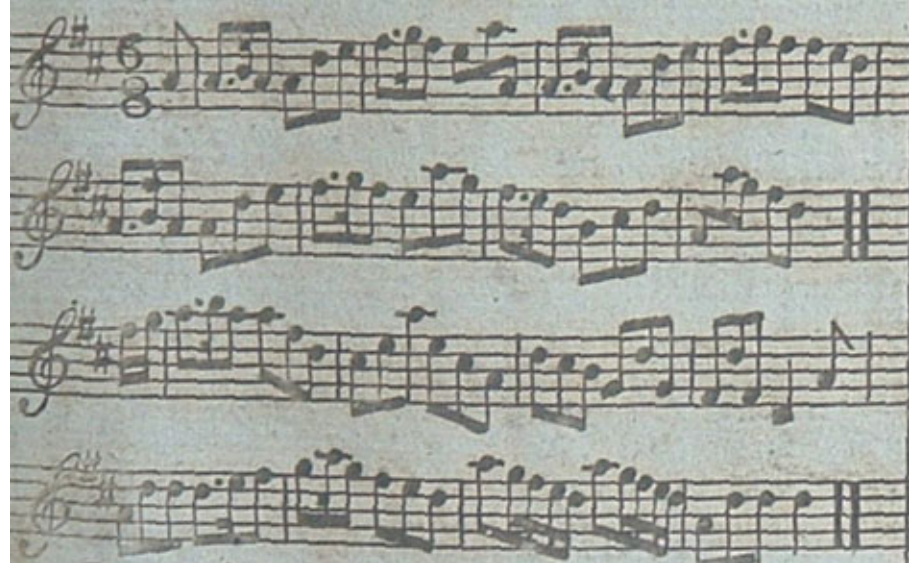
Hands six round and back again Allemande

Cu: and turn Right & left.

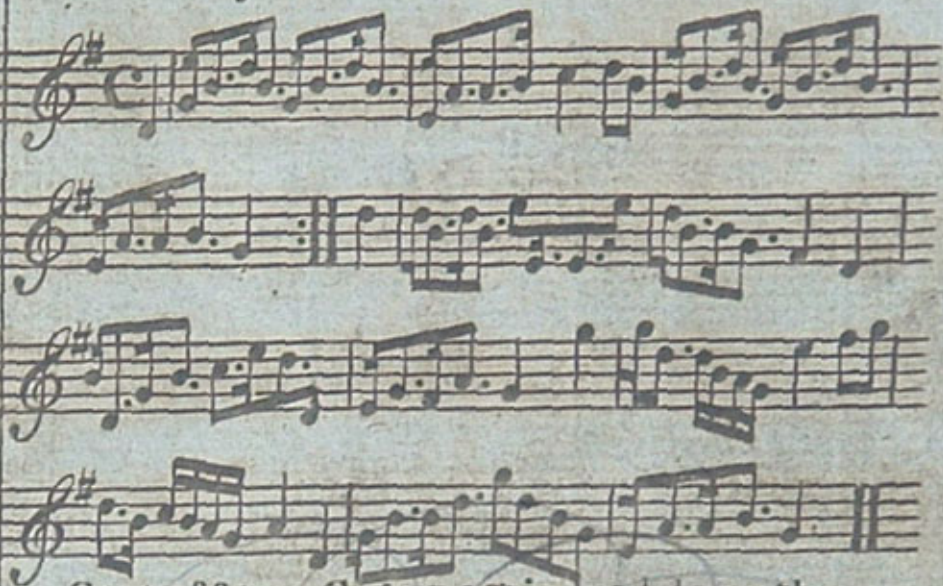

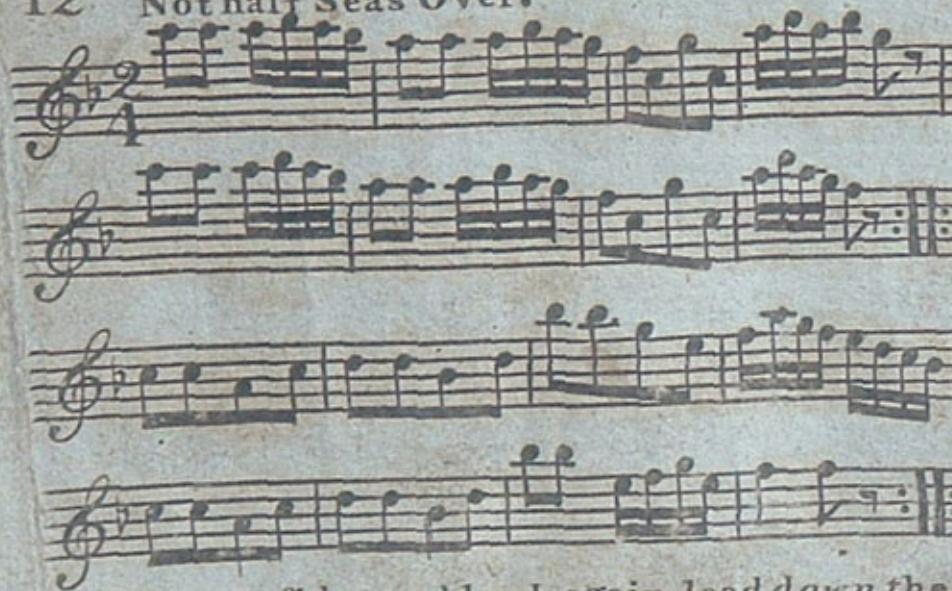
